Mayor Brening called the meeting to order at 5:25 p.m. in the Council Chambers of Manchester City Hall. Councilmember Dyer made a motion to approve the Agenda as written, motion seconded by Councilmember Ferguson. The vote was unanimous with 4 ayes.

Mayor Brening made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Ferguson to declare a state of emergency for the city of Manchester until further notice. The vote was unanimous with 4 ayes.

Mayor Brening made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Dyer to adopt a temporary curfew enacted by Meriwether County Board of Commissioners until further notice. The vote was unanimous with 4 ayes.

Councilmember Ferguson made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Dyer to temporarily waive procedures and fee structure for utility billing until further notice. The vote was unanimous with 4 ayes.

Mayor Brening asked that all parks containing playground equipment be posted with warning signs that the equipment was not sanitized.

Councilmember Taylor-Foster made a motion to adjourn at 6:32 p.m., seconded by Councilmember Ferguson. The vote was unanimous with 4 ayes.
